2024 Electric Bills Still Due

We have tried to convey the message that you must have your 2024 electric bills paid by Dec 31, 2024, to receive any discounted camping rate. There are about 25 electric bills from 2024 with a total of over three thousand dollars that have not yet been paid. Each year we average about \$1200 in unpaid electric bills. These shortages may lead to a deposit being collected in the future.

Having your bill paid by Dec 31st gives you the opportunity to save up to \$500.00 on your seasonal camping as an early pay discount. This also allows us to finalize our 2024 books before the end of the year.

We are offering a one-time offer to those who have not yet paid and are coming back for 2025. If you pay your electric bill before February 15th, we will allow for half of the discount for 2025 camping. Therefore, if you pay your electric bill now, you can save \$250.00 on your camping if paid before March 1st. Please call or come in and settle up for 2024 so we can start fresh in 2025.





"Flushable" wipes are no longer permitted in our septic system. Please refrain from using them in our restrooms or dumping them into your black tank if you are planning on having us dump you or using our dump station. These wipes do not fully dissolve and cause backups in our system and problems with the honey dipper. I will spare you the details of how they had to clear out the obstruction. Please, please, please do not flush wipes of any kind into your black tank and only us RV toilet paper. The chemical you put into your tank to break down RV toilet paper will not breakdown household toilet paper or wipes. Save yourself the headache in the future and throw wipes into the trash. This may not be the number one article in the Chatter, but it is, number two.





I hope all our winter campers are doing well. Most of you I have spoken with recently and it seems that you are. Fortunately, we have only had a few snow falls which created the need to plow the roads. I would like to thank Rick, Lynn and Shane for their help with that.

You have been very mindful about where you park, and I appreciate that. In the spring, we should have fewer ruts to fill which will give the guys more time to focus on other beautification projects around the campground.

We have been fighting with the water heater recently and apologize to anyone who was inconvenienced by it. Please let us know if there are any other issues with the facilities and we will get right on it.

Please remember to keep both of your sites, summer and winter, in good order. We are starting to call campers to look at sites and would like to give a good impression of our campground. Also, once the water gets turned back on, please let us know when you will be moving so we can get the electric meters switched.

Only a couple months left of really cold temps and the great migration back to your summer site begins. I pray that temperatures get back to regular cold instead of the *minus zero polar vortex cold* we have been dealing with lately. Everyone stay warm and remember to keep that propane full.

I appreciate the service work you are trusting us with and, I very much appreciate those who sign up for internet service this season to help us cover the cost of providing it.
